(ii) **Parish Cemetery** - The path is becoming overgrown with weeds, the wall at the top end was overgrown with ivy and the ivy is also growing up the wall to the roof of the gable end of St Margaret's Hall. There was a self-set Elder and Dog Rose in one of the graves and brambles in the bushes next to the Yew tree in front of the shed. RESOLVED to agree that Councillor Matkin will weed spray the path and ivy on the Cemetery wall and cut off the ivy at ground level which is growing up the wall of St Margaret's Hall. Clerk to ask the grounds maintenance contractor to remove the brambles, Elder, Dog Rose and to trim the area over the wall at the end of St Margaret's Hall
